

# French Artist in Residence Program

## Application Guidelines

### 1. Introduction

LUCfest's residence program provides opportunities for musicians and composers with no genre restrictions.

Located in Tainan, Taiwan, the program allows participants in the program to come into contact with the music scene in Taiwan as well as devote themselves to their creative endeavors in a dynamic environment while interacting with the local community.

Created in a world first collaboration between founding partners **Bureau français de Taipei (BFT)**, **Tainan City Government**, along with program host **LUCfest**.

Supported by **Institut Français**, **Centre National de la Musique**, and **Taiwan Creative Content Agency (TAICCA)**. The residency program is an initiative created to continue strengthening collaboration between artists in international music markets within the challenging parameters of the COVID 19 pandemic.

## **3. Eligibility**

### **The applicant must:**

- Be a musicians/composers, no genre restrictions
- Possess a nationality of France
- Be able to perform publicly
- Able to enter Taiwan legally.
- Not be enrolled at an educational institution during the program period unless it is a PhD program.
- Be in a state of good health and able to carry out daily activities on his/her own.
- Have an English-language ability proficient enough to communicate with other artists and staff.
- Work with Taiwanese musicians/composers/producers for their final work (at least 1 track ready for release)

## **4. Program Provisions**

The residency covers:

- Accommodation: Each artist is provided with a furnished studio-style apartment that includes basic electric appliances. The artist's partner is allowed to accompany him/her. However, the artist is solely responsible for a partner's expenses as well as safety. Please be aware that accommodation provided by residency program is only for single occupants.
- Recording facility: A studio will be provided upon request.
- Working Space: A space at a co-working space or artist village will be provided.
- Performance opportunities: Each artist is provided performance slots from 25th-28th Nov. **2021** at LUCfest .
- Transportation fee: Artists from overseas: Round-trip (economy class) airfare from the international airport nearest his/her home to Taoyuan International Airport or Kaohsiung International Airport is provided.
- Allowance: The artist is provided with NTD42,000 for living and other basic expenses as well as a grant of NTD 175000 (5000 Euro). In total, NTD is NTD217,000 provided for the 42-day program period.
